The need for Social Distancing, hopefully has taught us any number of lessons. One of those lessons may have been how much we need each other and how much we depend on one another. I hope and pray that in the enforced time together, you've rediscovered the many strengths of family life. I hope and pray that spouses have strengthened the unique foundation in their relationship which initially brought them to exchange their vows as husband and wife.
